

KENYA TEA INDUSTRY PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS FOR SEPTEMBER 2024

PRODUCTION

Tea production for the month of September 2024 was lower by 5.89 Million Kgs from 48.30 Million Kgs recorded during the same period of last year to 42.41 Million Kgs. Lower production was attributed to generally low rainfall and cool weather conditions experienced in the tea growing regions within the West and East of Rift Valley, respectively, which unlike last year, recorded moderate and well distributed precipitation.

During the month of September, most of the tea growing areas within the West of Rift experienced low to moderate rainfall of between 5mm to 48 mm daily with the exception of Kericho, which recorded higher precipitation of ranging from 20 to 73 mm daily. However, precipitation within the tea growing areas in the East of Rift was relatively lower compared to the West of Rift at a maximum of less than 18 mm daily during the first half of the month. However, dry weather conditions was recorded in the East of Rift during the second half.

Owing to relatively low rainfall followed by dry weather conditions, production in tea growing areas within the East of Rift Block was significantly lower by 4.22 Million Kgs from 17.19 Million Kgs recorded in the month of September 2023 to 12.97 Million Kgs. Similarly, due to low and moderate rainfall in most parts of the West of Rift Block, the output was lower by 1.67 Million Kgs from 31.11Million Kgs to 29.44 Million Kgs. Within the West of Rift, the most affected producers were the Independent and Estate factories, respectively due to their wider coverage in areas that experienced low rainfall conditions, mostly in Bomet and Kisii/Nyamira counties. Consequently, Independent tea producers who majorly source Greenleaf from the smallholder farmers recorded a production decline of 2.28 Million Kgs from 12.28 Million Kgs to 10 Million Kgs. Similarly, output from the Estate tea factories was lower by 1 Million Kgs from 12.12 Million Kgs to 11.11Million Kgs.



The Smallholder tea sub-sector, which has a wider coverage in the East of Rift recorded lower production by 2.52 Million Kgs from 23.44 Million Kgs in the corresponding month of 2023 to 20.92 Million Kgs.


Cumulatively up to the month of September, production for the year 2024 was higher by 7.99% (32.95 Million Kgs) from 412.22 Million Kgs recorded during the first nine months of 2023 to 445.17 Million Kgs. Higher production was due to favourable weather recorded during the first four months of the year, with rainfall ranging from near-to-above the long-term average amounts compared to the trend for the same period over the years owing to *El-Nino* weather phenomenon.

Realizing the Tea Promise
TEA PRODUCTION TREND (2024 VIS.-A-VIS. 2023)



During the month of September, the volume of speciality teas produced was 710,560 Kgs, which represented 2% of the total production. Speciality teas were dominated by Orthodox teas at 92% (651,527.90 Kgs) and was largely produced by Estates and Independents tea factories, respectively. The rest of speciality teas consisted of Green and Purple tea produced by the Cottage tea industries.

TEA SALES

AUCTION

Auction sales volume for Kenya tea during the month of September stood at 22.60 Million Kgs, which was lower compared to 27.37 Million kgs recorded during the corresponding month of last year. However, compared to the month of August, absorption for teas offered under the main catalogue was fairly good at 58% from 54%.



The average monthly auction price for Kenya tea was slightly higher at 2.25 USD per Kg against 2.10 USD for the same period of last year. However, prices of tea followed the quality with "Good" to "Medium" categories across the grades (well sorted and brighter liquors) attracting more competitive bids and considerably higher prices compared to "Lower Medium" and "Plainer" teas, which attracted either less interest and thus discounted prices or no offers and consequently constituted the highest proportion of teas on offer at the auction that were withdrawn. Depending on the quality band, the leaf grades generally attracted relatively higher prices than the dust and secondary grades, respectively.

During the month of September 2024, tea offered for sale by the smallholder tea factories managed by KTDA, whose quality is relatively higher fetched an average price of 2.89 USD per Kg for the main grades.

Though there was generally good demand for tea offered at the auction, the prices continued to be impacted negatively by high supply compared to demand. The sale of tea at the auction continued to be affected by the effects of global economic shock experienced in most countries due to the Russia-Ukraine crisis and market access challenges owing to internal conflict in Sudan as well as shipment disruptions through the Red Sea. This affected sale of certain Grades of tea at the auction leading to lower absorption and outlots.

EXPORTS

The total export volume for the month of September 2024 was higher by 4.44% (2.16 Million Kgs) from 48.76 Million Kgs recorded in the same period of last year to 50.92 Million Kgs. Higher export volume was attributed to more shipment of tea to the traditional and emerging markets. During the month, Kenya tea was shipped to sixty (60) export destinations which was similar to the same period of last year with Pakistan maintaining its leading position having imported 18.53 Million Kgs, accounting for 36% of the total export volume. Egypt, which is the second largest export destination imported 7.67 Million Kgs and was followed by UK (5.14 Million Kgs); India (3.20 Million Kgs); UAE (2.06 Million Kgs); Iran (1.74 Million Kgs); Russia (1.43 Million Kgs); China (1.07 Million Kgs); Poland (0.93 Million Kgs); and Sudan (0.75 Million Kgs). The top ten export destinations, majority of which are traditional markets for Kenya tea accounted for 84% of Kenya tea export volume. Apart from Pakistan, Russia, Sudan, Jordan, Yemen, Saudi Arabia and Afghanistan, all the other traditional, non-traditional and emerging markets recorded higher imports for Kenya tea. Internal conflict in Sudan has continued to affect the market access for tea leading to low export volume. Shipments to other markets such as Europe and North Africa has also been affected by continued attacks on vessels along the Red Sea by Yemen Terrorist group leading to longer voyage times and higher freight rates through the alternative shipment route around Africa's Cape of Good Hope.

During the month, Chad continued to expand rapidly as an emerging market for Kenya tea owing to direct importation from Kenya through Nigeria and Cameroon as alternative transhipment routes following disruption of its import transhipment route through Sudan due to internal conflict. Just like Chad, South Sudan is also rapidly growing as an emerging market for Kenya tea. There were also shipments to seasonal markets such as Burkina Faso; New Zealand; Georgia; and Cameroon.



During the month of September, value added tea exports amounted to 1.42 Million Kgs, which represented 3% of the total exported volume. The exports in value added form were shipped to twenty-six (26) market destinations which included United Kingdom; Oman; United States; Somalia; Sudan; Burkina Faso; Chad; Cote D'ivoire; Ireland; South Sudan; Taiwan; Mauritania; India; DRC Congo; Brazil; Japan; Italy; Malaysia; United Arab Emirates; Swaziland; South Africa; Egypt; Belgium; Australia; Israel; and Netherlands.

Out of the total exports of value-added tea, United Kingdom accounted for the highest volume at 41% and was followed by Oman at 20%. United States and Somalia accounted for 13% and 10%, respectively. Other significant importers of value-added teas included Sudan; Burkina Faso; Chad; and Cote D'ivoire.

During the nine-month period of 2024, Kenya tea export volume was higher by 24.72% (90.62 Million Kgs) from 366.58 Million Kgs recorded in the same period of last year to 457.20 Million Kgs. The export earnings was also higher at Kshs 142 Billion against Kshs 124 Billion for the same period of last year on account of higher export volume and stable exchange rate to the USD.

LOCAL TEA SALES

Local tea sales for September 2024 was lower at 2.74 Million Kgs against 2.99 Million Kgs in September 2023 but higher compared to 3.68 Million Kgs recorded the corresponding month of 2022. However, cumulative tea sales for the first nine months of 2024 was much higher at 27.23 Million Kgs against 27.19 Million Kgs for the same period of 2023 and 24.58 Million Kgs for the period January to September 2022.
