KENYA TEA INDUSTRY PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS FOR FEBRUARY 2022 PRODUCTION

Tea production for the month of February 2022 dropped significantly by 7.86 Million Kgs from 48.68 Million Kgs recorded in January to 40.82 Million Kgs. Production during the month was also lower compared to 43.39 Million Kgs recorded in during the same period of last year. The drop in production for the month of February was due to ontinued sunny and dry weather conditions condition that was recorded over most parts of the country and across the tea growing regions. The effect was more prevalent in tea growing areas the West of Rift especially in Kericho, Nandi, and Nyamira where rainfall was minimal at an average of between 2 mm to 18 mm daily during the first half of the month. However, a few areas over the highlands West of Rift Valley such as Kisii received moderate rainfall. As a result of dry weather conditions and minimal rainfall in most tea growing areas in the West of Rift, production within the West of Rift was significantly lower by 3.01 Million Kgs from 27.93 Million Kgs recorded during the same month of 2021 to 24.92 Million Kgs.

Notably, the effect of sunny weather in tea growing areas in the East of the Rift was minimal as highlands East of the Rift Valley and the Central Rift Valley, recorded near to below average rainfall in comparison with the February Long Term Means (LTMs). In the East of Rift, only tea growing areas in Embu/Meru region recorded dry weather conditions while the other tea growing regions recorded moderate rainfall averaging 2-27mm daily. Consequently, output within the East of Rift recorded a marginal increase of 0.44 Million Kgs from 15.46 Million Kgs to 15.90 Million Kgs.

Notably, due to wider coverage of the Plantation sub-sector in tea growing areas affected by adverse weather conditions in the West of Rift (Nandi, Kericho, Bomet, and

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Nyamira Counties), the sub-sector recorded lower production by 3.33 Million Kgs from 19.69 Million Kgs to 16.36 Million Kgs. However, since the Smallholder Sub-sector is more wide-spread in areas that was not adversely affected by drought, the sub-sector's output recorded a marginal increase of 0.76 Million Kgs from 23.70 Million Kgs recorded during the corresponding month of 2021 to 24.46 Million Kgs.

TEA SALES

AUCTION

During the month of February, auction sales volume for Kenyan tea stood at 36.40 Million Kgs, which was lower compared to 37.45 Kgs Million recorded in the month of January and 37.82 Million Kgs sold in the corresponding month of last year. The average monthly auction price for Kenyan tea was higher at 2.73 USD per Kg against 2.11 USD for the same period of 2021 and 2.13 USD for the same period of 2020. The average price was also higher compared to 2.68 USD recorded in the month of January this year. During the month of February 2022, auction prices continued on an upward trajectory after experiencing a declining trend to a seven-month low of 1.75 USD per Kg in July 2021. Reversed trend follows the setting up of minimum reserve price of 2.43 USD per Kg in July for the smallholder sub-sector taking into account the cost of production, the grade of the tea and a reasonable return to the tea farmer. During the month of February 2022, tea offered for sale by the smallholder tea factories fetched an average price of 2.97 USD per Kg for the main grades from an average price of 2.33 USD in July 2021.

For all the tea offered for sale at the auction during the month, "Best" category of CTC leaf grades fetched higher prices at between USD 2.82 to 4.50 per Kg for the BP1s and 3.05 to 3.76 for the PF1s while tea prices for a similar category of the dust grades ranged between USD 3.05 to 3.68 for PDust and USD 3.30 to 3.69 for Dust1. Notably, well sorted grades and those with brighter liquors attracted more competitive bids and considerably higher prices while plainer categories across the grades attracted either less interest and thus lower prices or no bid by the buyers and consequently constituted the highest proportion of teas on offer at the auction that were withdrawn. However, there was no Orthodox tea grades on offer at the auction during the month.

EXPORTS

The total export volume for the month of February 2022 was 45.12 Million Kgs, which was lower compared with 48.31 Million Kgs recorded in the same period of last year and 45.94 Million Kgs in January. Out of the total export volume, 99% was CTC teas and 1% was Orthodox teas.

During the month, Kenya tea was shipped to fifty two (52) export destinations compared to forty nine (49) for the same period of last year. Pakistan maintained the leading export destination for Kenyan tea having imported 18.74 Million Kgs, accounting for 42% of the total export volume. Other key export destinations for Kenyan tea were Egypt (9 Million Kgs), Russia (3.07 Million Kgs), UK (2.86 Million Kgs), Yemen (2.13 Million Kgs), UAE (1.63 Million Kgs), Kazakhstan (0.848 Million Kgs), Sudan (0.797 Million Kgs), Iran (0.773 Million Kgs) and Poland (0.547 Million Kgs),. The top ten export destinations, majority of which are traditional markets for Kenyan tea accounted for 90% of Kenya tea export volume.

During the month, there was significant increase in exports to traditional markets especially Pakistan, Russia, Yemen and Iran and emerging markets such as Jordan; and Eritrea. There were also a few shipments to seasonal markets such Lithuana; Burkina Faso; Taiwan; Guinea; Malta; Togo; and Brazil.

LOCAL TEA SALES

Local tea sales for February 2022 stood at 2.00 Million Kgs against 2.96 Million Kgs for the corresponding period of 2021 while cumulative tea sales for the two months period up to February 2022 was 4.63 Million Kgs against 5.91 Million Kgs for the same period of 2021.
